

BE A PART OF THIS *Xtreme* ADVENTURE ITINERARY

Day one

- Depart from your destination for Upington
- Arrive in Upington. Upington is the principal town and commercial, educational and social centre of the Green Kalahari region, owing its prosperity to agriculture and its irrigated lands along the Orange River.
- Travel further to a perfect River Camp designed for the true outdoor enthusiast which offers a wide choice of accommodation, outdoor activities such as 4 x 4 trails, Orange River Rafting, horse riding, fishing, abseiling and much more.
- Check in and enjoy lunch.
- Depart for your first adventure activity.
Activity: Half day river rafting on the Augrabies RUSH section. This is an amazing trip; you will be taken into the heart of the desert, floating on The Mighty Orange River. This section consists of approximately 4 big graded rapids assured to get the blood and adrenalin pumping. On completion of the river rafting, relax and enjoy a short walk to the Augrabies Waterfalls!

- Return back to camp to relax around an African fire and enjoy a home cooked campfire cuisine.

Day two

- Early start to the day with coffee, rusks and a light breakfast before departing to Riemvasmaak for a breath taking 148m abseil down the Molopo gorge.
- From there enjoy a hike down to the mouth of the Molopo river and see where it meets this ancient water source we call the Orange river.
- After this relax in the natural springs just below, whilst enjoying refreshments and a bite to eat.
- The drive in and out offers a great 4x4 off road experience just to ensure that we keep your adventurous side enticed.
- Return to the River Rest Camp and take part in a desert mountain bike ride - this is not your average dune ride, its extremely rocky and hot, posing to be quite a challenge.
- Enjoy sundowners and dinner on the deck overlooking the river.

Day Three

- Enjoy a hearty breakfast.
- Transfer to a 7500 hectare farm, saddle up, and depart for an amazing 3hr outdrive on this spectacular farm where you'll be greeted by a variety of antelope, Giraffe, and indigenous plants. Horseback is a great way to view the wild and nature as animals allow you to get a lot closer to them this way without being a threat.
- Welcome the afternoon with a cooling activity; a white water kayaking course where you will be taught the basics of Eskimo rolling, river reading, paddle strokes, bracing and lots more.
- After the water sports, relax and enjoy lunch.
- Late afternoon take you back into the water for some Extreme fly fishing which includes wading into the rapids, stalking fish reeling in and landing the fish, casting techniques etc.
- Tired yet inspired - relax and enjoy dinner

Day Four

- Enjoy breakfast and return to your destination
